DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club (including mixed breeds), or are a registerable breed that has obtained an AKC, ILP, PAL or MA number; except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRIES & FEES: MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to **SOTC**. All fees are payable in US funds. **ENTRY FEE** \$33.00 for first entry of a dog, and \$27.00 for additional entry of same dog on the same day, (*Includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee per entry and \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee for the 1st entry in Obedience*). Mail entries and fees **along with a copy of your vaccination card if vaccinated to** SOTC, c/o Theresa Nolan, 503 Sylvan Avenue, Bayport, N.Y. 11705-1538. **ENTRIES NOT ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM** or photocopies of an entry form without the agreement will not be accepted. Fax, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Returned

checks do not constitute a valid entry. A charge of \$25 will be made for each returned check. Entry fees shall not be returned in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund will be made.

All Entries must include a signed COVID-19 Waiver. If you do not want to wear a mask, remember to submit a copy of your vaccination card with your entry.

Errors – Exhibitors are responsible for filling out complete, accurate entries and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or the cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

No hand delivery of entries.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as the trial closes or when limits are reached.

No Bitches in season allowed. Refunds less \$10.00 administrative fee will be made for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial. A written request must be made accompanied by a letter from a veterinarian within 24 hours of trial completion.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are solely responsible for getting their dogs to the ring on time.

SITE INFORMATION

Protocols & Procedures

Due to the Covid-19 virus pandemic we have had to make some changes and add procedures to enable us to hold the obedience trial as safely as possible. We will be following the mandates set by the State of New York as well as the protocols set by the Suffolk Obedience Board. Due to the continuously changing nature of the pandemic, please realize that some changes may be necessary prior to the trial. If any changes are required, the new protocols and procedures will be communicated to you by the trial secretary.

- Masks, **which fully cover your mouth and nose, are required** at all times in the building, including when exhibiting your dog, **if not fully vaccinated.**
- Masks, which fully cover your mouth and nose, are strongly recommended for vaccinated individuals.
- Temperature checks will be performed as you enter the facility. If your temperature is normal, you will be issued a wristband that is to be worn for the day.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet is required while in the facility. Frequent hand washing/sanitizing is recommended.
- The number of persons inside the facility and in each area will be limited. Only the dog competing and the next dog in the ring will be allowed in the facility.
- There will be no spectators permitted at this time.
- Exhibitors shall wait outside at a safe distance until trial personnel indicates they may enter the facility.
- We will allow handlers to enter the building to use the restroom facilities. Handlers may be asked to wait outside until others have exited to ensure we have not exceeded the allowed count of persons in the facility.
- There will be **NO CRATING** of exhibitor's dogs in the building.
- There will be no food or water provided. Everyone should bring their own food/water for themselves and their dogs.

Instructions shall be given at briefings and posted throughout the show site. **If you feel ill for any reason, PLEASE stay home. Any person not cooperating or complying with the trial protocols shall be excused from the trial site and NO REFUND shall be issued. We are doing our best to ensure everyone has a safe and fun weekend. We appreciate your cooperation and patience and thank you in advance.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. - Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
