DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months or over that are registered with the American Kennel Club (including mixed breeds), or are a registerable breed that has obtained an AKC, ILP, PAL or MA number; except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRIES & FEES: MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to SOTC. All fees are payable in US funds. ENTRY FEE Per Trial: \$33.00 for first entry of a dog, and \$27.00 for additional entry of same dog, (Includes \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee per entry for Rally).
