DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club (including mixed breeds), or are a registerable breed that has obtained an AKC, ILP, PAL or MA number; except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRIES & FEES: MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to **SOTC**. All fees are payable in US funds. **ENTRY FEE** \$30.00 for first entry of a dog, and \$20.00 for additional entry of same dog, (*Includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee per entry and \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee for the 1st entry in Obedience*). Mail entries and fees to SOTC, c/o Helen Havran, 37 Hedgerow La., Commack, NY 11725. **ENTRIES NOT ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM** or photocopies of an entry form without the agreement will not be accepted. Fax, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A charge of \$25 will be made for each returned check. Entry fees shall not be returned in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund will be made. **Errors** – Exhibitors are responsible for filling out complete, accurate entries and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or the cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

No hand delivery of entries.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as the trial closes or when limits are reached.

No Bitches in season allowed. Refunds less \$10.00 administrative fee will be made for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial. A written request must be made accompanied by a letter from a veterinarian within 24 hours of trial completion.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are solely responsible for getting their dogs to the ring on time.

SITE INFORMATION

- **There will be NO set up on Thursday Night.** The Training Center will be open at 7:00 AM on Friday the 29th.
- Please park in the designated parking areas next to the building and in the adjacent parking lots.
- There is a designated “potty” area. Please clean up after your dog and place waste in the receptacles provided by the Club. **DO NOT** use any dumpster or allow dogs to urinate on the buildings.
- Crating Space is limited, but should accommodate all entered dogs. Please do not bring dogs that are not competing into the building.
- **NO EX-PENS. Also, crates CANNOT be left overnight, as we need to accommodate all entered dogs.**
- Snacks and beverages will NOT be available, so please plan accordingly.

From Points North:

Northern State Parkway to Exit 44 South or LI Expressway to Exit 53 South – Sagtikos/Southern State Parkway South to Exit S3/PineAire Drive Exit.

Toward Deer Park/Brentwood; take ramp toward Deer Park.

Turn Left onto Pine Aire Drive;

Turn Left onto Corbin Ave;

Take first right onto 2nd Street; #60X is on your left.

There are two rows of low taupe factory buildings. We are located in the very last building on the right. Just drive down the row of parked cars and buildings to the back corner unit. (careful of the speed bumps !!!)
